Preparation	Papers with symbols on.
Description	The instructor divides participants into two smaller groups. Each group receives a paper with a symbol that they creatively embody with their bodies. Once the instructor approves the symbol, they hide it for the other group to find. Subsequently, each group receives papers with different letters. Now, each group divides into three stations. The first station, holding the letters, walks each letter on the ground for the second group to decipher and recreate with their bodies. In the meantime, one member from the third group observes, while the other faces away. The observer from the third group tries to write the letter on someone in the same group's back, who then writes it on a piece of paper. Repeat this process for each letter until all are completed. Finally, everyone comes together to decipher the word formed by these letters.
Guidelines for the facilitator	 Clear Symbol Selection: Ensure symbols chosen for embodying are clear and easily representable with body movements. Encourage creativity in interpreting symbols. Effective Hiding of Symbols: Guide groups in hiding their symbols effectively for an engaging retrieval challenge by the other group.















•	Ensure fairness in symbol hiding to maintain the

Smooth Transition Between Stations:

- Facilitate smooth transitions between stations during the letter deciphering process.
- Encourage efficient communication within groups and across stations.

Observation and Writing Techniques:

- Instruct the observer from the third group to keenly observe and accurately write the deciphered letters.
- Emphasize clear communication to avoid misunderstandings during the letter-writing process.

Word Deciphering Collaboration:

- Guide participants in collaborative efforts to decipher the word formed by the letters.
- Foster an inclusive atmosphere where every participant's contribution is valued.

Adaptability and Encouragement:

- Be adaptable to the group's dynamics and adjust the pace as needed.
- Encourage positive reinforcement, fostering a supportive environment for creative expression.
